ABOUT US

The Holy Redeemer was founded in 1927 by the Church of England in Streatham Vale, London to serve the local area.

There are about 135 in our fellowship, of which around 30 are under the age of 18. Our church family is ethnically diverse with both young and old from different backgrounds.

We have three services every Sunday and run a variety of activities during the week, including *Little Nippers* toddler group and youth events for the local community.

We believe that we can know God by hearing His words in the Bible. So Bible teaching is an important part of our services as well as singing, praying and friendship.

We are not a perfect church; we are people who live imperfect lives. But we have found that God forgives us and changes us through Jesus Christ - and that's good news for everyone!

Our aim is to make this good news known and to live for him. We try to be a place that cares for people and allows them to ask questions of the Christian faith. Everyone is most welcome.

BELIEFS

The name 'The Holy Redeemer' comes from the Bible's title for Jesus. A 'redeemer' is someone who buys back something by paying a price. The Bible says that we have not loved God or each other as we should. But God sent his son, Jesus, to *pay the price* for our wrong doing by dying on the cross. We can now be forgiven and enjoy an everlasting relationship with God if we trust our lives to him. We come to trust Jesus by listening to his words in the Bible.
